Mary Kingsley

Mary Kingsley is a famous scientific writer and explorer. She was from London, England. She was born there in 1862. She was the daughter of George Kingsley and Mary Bailey. Her father was a doctor.

Mary's first journey was to the Canary Islands. In 1895, she arrived on the west coast of Africa. Her plan was to travel up the Ogoouè River in Gabon. She wanted to study the way people lived in that part of the world. On 5th June, she left the port of Glass and travelled by boat to Ndjolè. When she was traveling she changed to a canoe because the boats couldn't travel further up the river.

As she was going up the river, she stopped to collect fish. She collected 65 different types of fish. Three of them were named after her. In 1897, Mary wrote a book about her travels. It is called Travels in Africa.

Mary was also a nurse. She helped ill people in South Africa but she got ill herself. Sadly, she died in 1900 in Cape Town at a very young age. She will always be remembered because she did things that no other woman her age had ever done before.

Read the following two texts carefully and answer the following questions:



A) People have been using their computers to shop for over a decade now. It's easy to do and it's mostly safe, although some people are still a little nervous. You'll need a credit or debit card and a secure password. This is something you can make up, something unique to you and something can't be guessed.

B) A different password for each site you use is ideal – perhaps a set of squiggles you can memorize followed by the name of the site you're using. So, your password for this site might be &*^\$^bbcwebwise – as long as nobody knows the &*^\$^ bit, it's unique and pretty safe.

C) Online shopping is easy. Go to the site on which you want to shop. Click on the item you want, click "add to basket" and then stop. Check that the web address in the browser starts with https (rather than http) – this means they're using some sort of security when handling your money.

D) Enter your credit or debit card details. There will often be a few random characters on a display and you'll be asked to enter those too. This is called 'Captcha', and it's a way of making sure you're a real person, not a piece of software designed to defraud. So, you enter your details, complete your purchase and wait for your goods to arrive. It's as straightforward as that!

E) Online shopping is brilliant for 'commodity' products such as books, CDs, clothes – stuff that's going to be identical, no matter where you get it from. Many supermarkets offer an online shopping service with delivery and most are excellent. Auctions are another way of shopping. You can set up an account with an online money transfer account and link it to your bank or debit/credit details. PayPal currently has a monopoly on this kind of service.

F) A final word to say, if a website has no address and doesn't give you a procedure on what to do if there's a problem and you need to return goods, it's in breach of the Distance Selling Regulations (consumer protection law) and shouldn't be used.
